

**Scripture Reading:** Isaiah 35:8-10



As many of us prepare to hit the highway during these last weeks of 2017, let's take a moment to think about the "highway of life." To begin, look at **Proverbs 16**:

- All the ways of a man are pure in his \_\_\_\_\_ eyes, but the LORD weighs the spirit (v. 2)
