### January

- 6 The view from the Cross (Ps 22:1-5)

- 3 The author of our salvation (Heb 5:9)

- 21 He was pierced through for our transgressions (Isa 53:5)
- 28 He is not here, for He is risen (Mt 28:6)

### May

- 5 Go quickly and tell His disciples that He has risen (Mt 28:7)
- 12 Christ is our life (Col 3:4)
- 19 He was crushed for our iniquities (Isa 53:5)
- 26 We preach Christ crucified (1 Cor 1:23)

### June

- 2 This man has done nothing wrong (Lk 23:41)
- 9 You have been bought with a price (1 Cor 6:20)
- 16 He is the propitiation for our sins (1 Jn 2:2)
- 23 Do this in remembrance of Me (1 Cor 11:24)
- 30 We have become united with Him in the likeness of His death (Rom 6:5)

### July

- 7 You proclaim the Lord's death until He comes (1 Cor 11:26)
- 14 You have been brought near by the blood of Christ (Eph 2:13)
- 21 He destroyed the works of the devil (1 Jn 3:8)
- 28 He was not abandoned to Hades (Acts 2:33)

### August:

### September:

- 1 Draw near with confidence to the throne of Grace  
(Heb 4:16)
- 8 Christ bore our sins (1 Pet 2:24)
- 15 God has made Him both Lord and Christ (Acts 2:36)
- 22 By His wounds we are healed (Isa 53:5)
- 29 We are united in the likeness of His resurrection  
(Rom 6:5)

- 13 He sympathizes with our weaknesses (Heb 4:15)
- 20 His death fulfilled prophecy (1 Pet 1:10-11)
- 27 You have been born again through the living word  
(1 Pet 1:23)

### November:

- 3 Judas said, "I have sinned by betraying innocent  
blood" (Mt 27:4)
- 10 What shall I do with Jesus (Mt 27:22)
- 17 Jesus cried out, Eli, Eli, Lama Sabacthani (Mt 27:46)
- 24 He said "It is finished!" He bowed His head and  
gave up His spirit (Jn 19:30)

### December:

- 1 "...as it began to dawn on the first day of the week"  
(Mt 28:1)
- 8 "See My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself" (Lk  
24:39)
- 15 "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and  
rise again from the dead" (Lk 24:46)
- 22 You are witnesses of these things (Lk 24:48)
- 29 Blessed are they who did not see, and yet believed  
(Jn 20:29)
