- \_\_\_\_\_ is out of step with the gospel (Gal 2:13; Luke 12:1-9)

- \_\_\_\_\_ where God hasn’t \_\_\_\_\_ is out of step with the gospel (Gal 2:14-20)

- \_\_\_\_\_ the grace of God is out of step with the gospel (Gal 2:21; Eph 2:8-9)
