- 1. Moses asked Pharaoh to let the Israelites go. Pharaoh said, "No!" Color Pharaoh purple. Circle the word "No." Pharaoh's heart was hard and he would not listen. So God sent more plagues on Egypt.
- 2. Aaron held out his staff over the waters of Egypt and God made frogs come up and cover the land. Frogs were everywhere! Pharaoh said to Moses, "Please ask your God to take the frogs away and I will let you go!" Moses prayed to God and all the frogs died. Draw an X on the stinky, dead frogs. Pharaoh changed his mind and did not let the Israelites go.
- 3. Again, Moses asked Pharaoh to let the Israelites go. Pharaoh said, "No!" Circle the man who would not listen to Moses and Aaron.
- 4. Aaron hit the ground with his staff and God made the dust turn into gnats (tiny, flying bugs). Color Aaron's staff. All the dust in the land of Egypt became gnats! Pharaoh's magicians could not make gnats. The magicians knew the gnats came from God. Color the cloud yellow.
- 5. Again, Moses asked Pharaoh to let the Israelites go. What do you think Pharaoh said? Trace the word in the bubble.
- 6. Because Pharaoh's heart was still hard, God sent a plague of flies on Egypt. God did not send the flies to Goshen, the place where the Israelites lived. Draw happy faces on the Israelites. Pharaoh said the Israelites could go, but he was lying. Draw an X on the man who lied.
