

Ezekiel ("God will strengthen") lived 600 years prior to the appearance of the Son of God on earth. When Ezekiel was 17, Nebuchadnezzar–mighty king of the Babylonian empire–invaded Ezekiel's homeland and carried a great many Jews thousands of miles away into exile. At 25, Ezekiel himself was forcibly removed from his home in Jerusalem–with 10,000 other Jews–into captivity.

In Ezekiel 2, this young man is commissioned, and as long as he stands with God, he can rest assured in at least one thing: "they will ______ that a prophet has been among them" (2:5).
