As Peter describes the virtues of a Christian, he says, "For he who lacks these qualities is blind or short-sighted, having forgotten his purification from his former sins" (2 Pet 1:9). Short-sighted or near sighted, as other translations state, is nothing more than living for today.





A. Numbers 13

- 1. the report of the 10 spies was based solely upon what they saw (13:25-29). This report greatly discouraged Israel (14:1-4)
- 2. Joshua and Caleb saw the fortified cites, the strong people, the giants
 - they also saw what the Lord could do (14:8-9)
- 3. The Problem of short-sightedness is that we live day to day, only in the present. A person just tends to exist.
- 4. The physical perils of being near-sighted is that a person can't see road signs, stop lights, or dangers down the road until it is too late. Things in a distance are unclear.
 - School and home mortgages force us stay on a track about the future. A 20 or 30 year mortgage is a long time. Most don't think about 20 or 30 years down the road
 - Short-sightedness is illustrated in eating habits, living paycheck to paycheck - Fram Oil Filters: "You can pay me now, or you can pay me later"
- 5. Spiritual short-sightedness leads to the future being unclear and all the focus upon the present - Rev 3:17-18
