

First Passover

Exodus 11; 12:1-20

Discover the Bible

1. God spoke to Moses and said, "I am going to bring one more plague on Pharaoh and the Egyptians, then Pharaoh will let you go." Color the number 1. God wanted the Israelites to ask the Egyptians for things made of gold and silver.
2. Moses told Pharaoh that God was going to send the last plague at night. Color the moon and stars yellow. God would kill the firstborn son of all the people and animals in Egypt. God would not kill the firstborn son in the families of the Israelites. Circle the happy Israelite family.
3. God told the Israelites to eat a special meal called Passover. The Passover meal helped the Israelites remember and be thankful for the way God saved them from the Egyptians! The Israelites had to kill a lamb to eat. With red, circle the lamb.
4. God told the Israelites to put the lamb's blood on the doorframes of their houses. With red, color the blood on the doorframes. When God killed the firstborn sons in Egypt, he would *pass over* the houses of the people who had blood on their doorframe. Their firstborn son would not die!
5. God told the Israelites to eat the lamb meat with bitter herbs and bread that was flat. Color the food that the Israelites ate during the Passover meal. God told the Israelites to always remember this day and to celebrate it by eating the Passover meal every year.
