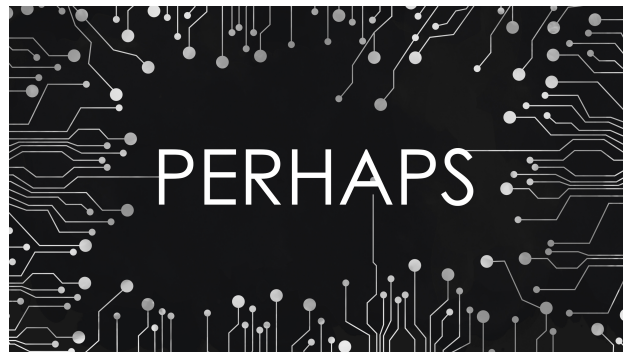


**“What’s God doing today?”** Sometimes answered with one of two extremes:

**“Who \_\_\_\_\_?”**

- Mordecai to \_\_\_\_\_ (4:12-14) - **“who knows whether you have not come...for such a time as this?”**
- \_\_\_\_\_ (2 Sam 12:21-23) - **“who knows whether the LORD will be gracious to me?”**
- \_\_\_\_\_ (2:13-14) - **“who knows whether he will not turn and relent?”**
- The king of \_\_\_\_\_ (Jonah 3:8-9) - **“who knows? God may turn and relent.”**

**“\_\_\_\_\_” and “Maybe”**

- \_\_\_\_\_ (Exo 32:30) - **“perhaps I can make atonement for your sin.”**
- \_\_\_\_\_ (5:15) - **“it may be that the LORD...will be gracious.”**
- \_\_\_\_\_ (2:3) - **“perhaps you may be hidden on the day of the anger of the LORD.”**
- \_\_\_\_\_ (Josh 14:12) - **“it may be that the LORD will be with me.”**
- \_\_\_\_\_ (1 Sam 14:6) - **“it may be that the LORD will work for us.”**
- Paul to \_\_\_\_\_ (15-16) - **“for this perhaps is why he was parted from you”**

**\_\_\_\_\_ : “Now I See”**

- Expresses great confidence in what God had accomplished (Gen 45:5-8; 50:20)...
- ...what we *aren’t* told is **when** Joseph reached this conclusion (Gen 41:51)

**What Can We See?**

1. There are the extremes, and then there is the \_\_\_\_\_. (Eccl 9:11,1)
2. We ought to \_\_\_\_\_ God’s presence, reign, and heart. (Dan 4:17; Psa 119:68)
3. We need to look for \_\_\_\_\_ to serve and glorify him. (Dan 3:16-18)
4. We ought to \_\_\_\_\_ to speak for God. (Eccl 5:2)
5. “Perhaps” our experiences and obstacles are opportunities to \_\_\_\_\_ much more than we initially realize. (Rom 5:1-5; James 1:2-4)
6. In the meantime, we walk by \_\_\_\_\_, not by sight. (2 Cor 5:6-10)
