The Beatitudes: Lesson Three

Blessed are those who Mourn

In this second beatitude, Jesus points out "Joy in Sorrow."

- Remember these are spiritual qualities of citizens of Jesus' kingdom
- Mourning here is not connected to anyone's death, funeral homes, or memorial services

. This beatitude is directly tied in to the first one, "blessed are the poor in spirit"

- Poor in spirit is what we are. It's seeing ourselves as we truly are
- This leads to how we feel about that situation. It causes us sorrow. We mourn.

The word Jesus uses here (pentheo) is that of extreme grief. It's a broken heart based upon the sins one has committed.
