## Carrying the Bones

The book of Genesis begins with God creating life. It ends with a "coffin in Egypt" (Gen 50:26). That coffin contained Joseph. As he was dying, he wanted to be buried in the land of promise (50:24-25). His body was embalmed and would have been given a national funeral because of his position (41:38-44).
