1 Timothy 1:1-7

Paul, an apostle of Christ
Jesus according to the commandment
of God our Savior, and of Christ
Jesus, who is our hope,

² To Timothy, *my* true son in *the* faith: Grace, mercy, *and* peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.

³ Just as I urged you upon my departure for Macedonia, to remain on at Ephesus so that you would instruct certain people not to teach strange doctrines, ⁴ nor to pay attention to myths and endless genealogies, which give rise to useless speculation rather than advance the plan of God, which is by faith, so I urge you now. 5 But the goal of our instruction is love from a pure heart, from a good conscience, and from a sincere faith. ⁶ Some people have strayed from these things and have turned aside to fruitless discussion, ⁷ wanting to be teachers of the Law, even though they do not understand either what they are saying or the matters about which they make confident assertions.
