## Ephesians 4:11-16

"And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, (12) to \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ the saints for the work of \_\_\_\_\_\_, for \_\_\_\_\_\_ up the body of Christ, (13) until we all attain to the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the faith and of the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the Son of God, to \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ, (14) so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes. (15) Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to \_\_\_\_\_\_ up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ, (16) from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love."
