Five differences between the creation account and evolution

1. The Bible teaches that the earth came before the sun (Gen 1:1, 14). Evolution teaches that the sun came first
2. The Bible teaches that life appeared on dry land (Gen 1:11). Evolution teaches that life originated in the sea
3. The Bible teaches that land animals appeared on the same day as man (Gen. 1:24-27). Evolution teaches that millions of years past between the first appearance of animals and the development of man.
4. The Bible teaches that death came into the world as a result of man's sin (Gen 3:19; 1 Cor 15:21). Evolution teaches that dinosaurs died out long before man appeared.
5. The Bible teaches that God created. Evolution teaches that man evolved over a long period of time.

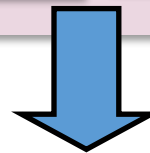
Evolution/Creation—why does it matter?

Biblical Worldview

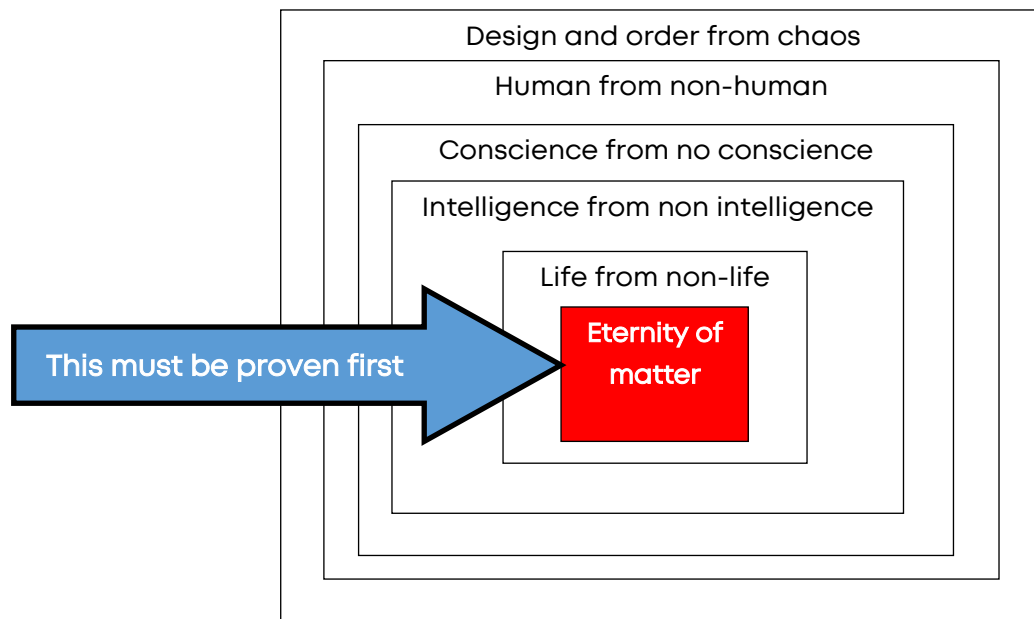
1. God created
