

In [John 4:24](#), Jesus taught us some **REALLY** important things about God and how to worship him:

“God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in _____ and _____.”

Truth. If we’re going to “offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe” ([Heb 12:28](#)), we have to listen to him. What does he want? What has he said true worship is?

Spirit. In [Matthew 15:8-9](#), Jesus warned that I can “honor” God with my lips, but if my “heart is far from” him, my “worship” is “vain.” My Father in heaven wants a real relationship with me. He wants to hear from me. How does that happen? Through **prayer**. What’s prayer? It’s talking from my heart to God. Can we even do that? Jesus taught us that we could. In [Matthew 6:9](#), he told us to pray like this: “Our Father in heaven...”


☑ **BIBLE Building Blocks:** our Old & New Testament books of the Bible; turning to books of the Bible without looking at the Table of Contents
