In **John 15:5**, Jesus said, "I am the _____; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit." **What sort of fruit?** Listen to what the apostle John wrote:

God is _____, and whoever abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him. (**John 4:16**)

Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love. In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, _____ also ought to love one another. (**John 4:8-11**)

The fruit of the Spirit is **LOVE**. **What IS love?** Love is doing what is _____ for others because we _____ about them. The apostle Paul put it this way in **1 Corinthians 13:4-7**:

Love is patient and _____; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

When we walk by the Spirit, connected to Jesus, we'll bear the fruit of **love** because **God** is **LOVE**.






