Finally, my brothers, rejoice _____ the Lord. (Phil 3:1)

Rejoice _____ the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice. (Phil 4:4)

Or, as Paul wrote in **1 Thessalonians 5:16-18**, "_____ always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."

When we walk by the Spirit, connected to Jesus, we'll bear the fruit of **JOY** because we **know** God **loves** us.


