day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness
that comes _____ Jesus Christ, to the
glory and praise of God. (**Phil 1:9-11**)

Have this mind among yourselves,
which is yours _____ Christ
Jesus... (**Phil 2:5**)

Finally, my brothers, rejoice _____
the Lord. (**Phil 3:1**)

Rejoice _____ the Lord always; again I will say,
rejoice. (**Phil 4:4**)

Or, as Paul put it in **1 Thessalonians 5:16-18**:

Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks
_____ all circumstances; for this is the will of God
_____ Christ Jesus for you.

When we walk by the Spirit, connected to Jesus, we'll
bear the fruit of **joy** because we **know** God loves us.

For Class & Family Discussion:

- ▶ Does this **joy** we're talking about always come **naturally** to us? If not, why not? What might be getting in the way?
- ▶ "Happiness" is often described as if it depends on whether or not we like what's happening around and to us. How is the mindset revealed in **Habakkuk 3:17-18** very different? How is it *better*?
- ▶ Can you think of other examples of men or women in the Bible who kept a positive attitude because they **knew** God loved them?
- ▶ How does the description of Jesus and what he did in **Hebrews 12:1-2** help us understand what **joy** really is? What are we being called to do as we follow in his footsteps?
- ▶ How does "walking by" the Spirit (**Gal 5:16**), following the "lead" of the Spirit (**Gal 5:18**), "keeping in step" with the Spirit (**Gal 5:25**) and "sowing to" the Spirit (**Gal 6:8**) produce the fruit of **joy**?
