

But the fruit of the Spirit is... (Gal 5:22-23)



In **John 15:5**, Jesus said, “I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit.” **What sort of fruit?** “The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, **PEACE...**”

Can you find **Philippians 4** in your Bible? It helps us learn all about this **peace**:

Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice. Let your reasonableness be known to everyone. The Lord is at hand; do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the _____ of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds _____ Christ Jesus. (4:4-7)

What is **PEACE**? **Feeling safe and calm because God is in charge.** Let’s keep listening:

Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. What you have learned and received and heard and seen in me —practice these things, and the _____ of peace will be _____ you. (4:8-9)

When we walk by the Spirit, connected to Jesus, we’ll bear the fruit of **PEACE** because we **know** God is in charge.


