What is **KINDNESS**? It's finding ways to _____ and **befriend** others.

Acts 28:1-2 gives us a good example of kindness:

After we were brought safely through, we then learned that the island was called Malta. The native people showed us **unusual** _____, for they kindled a fire and welcomed us all, because it had begun to rain and was cold.



Kindness is fruit that God expects from **ALL** of us!

Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, _____ in Christ forgave you. (**Eph 4:32**)

What about **GOODNESS**? It's learning what _____ God and doing it.

Romans 12:9-21 is **FULL** of the Spirit's fruit. Notice what it mentions:

Let love be genuine. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is _____. (**12:9**)

Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with **good**. (**12:21**)

When we walk by the Spirit, connected to Jesus, we'll learn what **good** things please God and do them with **kindness** in our hearts toward others.


