- Philippians 3:18-19 "For many walk, of whom I often told you, and now tell you even weeping, that they are enemies of the cross of Christ, whose end is destruction, whose god is their appetite, and whose glory is in the shame, who set their minds on earthly things."

- John Lennon sang in his song, "Imagine,"

- Popular books, like Rob Bell's Love Wins, teaches that in the end, God's love will melt even the hardest heart and all will be saved. Love wins in the end. All will be saved and none lost. That is Universalism.

The Doctrine of ______ is Misunderstood

It is commonly taught that God chooses specific people who will be saved. Nothing one does can change or alter that. So, in the end, it doesn't matter how you live, God has either chosen to save you or not. This is part of the Calvinistic TULIP system referred to as "Unconditional election" and "Limited Atonement."

Eph 1:4 "Just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him in love."

Col 3:12 "So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience."

1 Peter 2:9 "But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light."

- God chooses a "class" of people who will be saved, not specific individuals (Mark 16:15; John 3:16; 2 Pet 3:9)
- □ The blood of Jesus is available to all (1 John 2:2)
