



Our daily Bible reading has taken us to the foot of Mount Sinai and what must have been a truly awesome sight (Exo 19:1-9, 16-20; 20:18-21; 24:1-11).

The LORD said to Moses, “Come up to me on the mountain and \_\_\_\_\_ there, that I may give you the tablets of stone, with the law and the commandment, which I have written for their instruction.” So Moses rose with his assistant Joshua, and Moses went up into the mountain of God. And he said to the elders, “\_\_\_\_\_ here for us until we return to you. And behold, Aaron and Hur are with you. Whoever has a dispute, let him go to them.” (24:12-14)
