## A. There are several examples of when Jesus used the Bible

- When questioned by \_\_\_\_\_ (Mt 19:4-5)
- When questioned by \_\_\_\_\_ (Mt 22:29-32)
- When question by \_\_\_\_\_ (Mt 19:16-19)
- When in \_\_\_\_\_ with the men on the road to Emmaus (Lk 24:27)

- The Bible Jesus quoted from the most was the \_\_\_\_\_ or LXX
- This was the Hebrew Bible translated into Greek in the 3rd century B.C.
- 90% of His O.T. quotations came from the Septuagint (LXX)

- Jesus' calling ancient texts "Scripture" connected them to inspired writings (Lk 4:21; 24:27; Mt 21:42; 22:29)

  - Jonah and the fish
  - Queen of the South
  - Noah and the flood
  - Abel
  - Abraham
  - Lot's wife
