

# Prophecy & Other Things

In learning to study the Bible, it is important to understand the differences between the Testaments, which we commonly call the Old Testament (O.T.) and the New Testament (N.T.)

- The majority of the O.T., falls under the Law of Moses and it was written for Israel
  - the death and resurrection of Jesus brought a \_\_\_\_\_ in the law (Heb 9:16-17)
  - there was now a new covenant as Jeremiah prophesied (Jer 31:31-34, quoted in Heb 8:8-12)
  - the old law was "nailed" to the cross (Col 2:14) and became \_\_\_\_\_ (Heb 8:13)

  - this is why a study of the O.T. is valuable for us (Rom 15:4; 1 Cor 10:11)

- Our governing law today is the N.T. (Heb 1:1-2; Col 3:17)

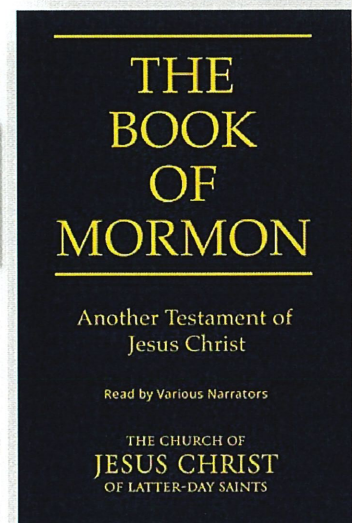
- we do not keep the "10 Commandments"
