the greatest commandment in the Law?" And how did Jesus answer? Listen carefully...

A lot of people have the wrong idea that love means letting me do whatever I want to do. That's exactly backwards. Love is giving myself up, first to God. Love is a **choice** to put others—God above all—ahead of myself. I honor God by presenting myself as a "living sacrifice" (Romans II:36-12:1). Love is the **commitment** of an imperfect person **to honor** a **perfect God**.
