## Jesus' Image of the Kingdom

The Kingdom of God was something that was a central theme in Jesus' preaching.

- His preaching began with: "...the kingdom of Heaven is at hand" (Mt 4:17)
- In teaching the disciples to pray, Jesus said to pray, "Thy kingdom come" (Mt 6:9)
- In the sermon on the mount Jesus said, "Seek first His kingdom" (Mt 6:33)

The most detailed image of the kingdom comes from a series of five parables in Matthew 13. Before that is explored, two concepts must be understood.

## (1) What did Jesus mean by the "Kingdom"

- sometimes the Lord said, "The Kingdom of Heaven," other times, "The Kingdom of God"
- (1) the realm of God's authority. Included would be salvation and truth
- (2) the word kingdom at times refers to the church (the saved) 1 Cor 15:24
- (3) kingdom can refer to governments or nations (Lk 4:5)
- a spiritual realm (Lk 17:21)
- the least in the kingdom is greater than the greatest (Mt 11:11)

## (2) What is a parable?
