
The Tabernacle

"And let them make me a sanctuary, that I may ______ in their midst. Exactly as I show you concerning the pattern of the tabernacle, and of all its furniture, so you shall make it." (Exo 25:8-9)

Throughout **Exodus 25-30**, the LORD reveals that pattern for his dwelling place among the children of Israel.



- The bronze altar (Exo 27:1-8)
- The bronze basin (Exo 30:17-21)
- The tabernacle (Exo 26)
- The table for bread (Exo 25:23-30)
- The golden lampstand (Exo 25:31-40)
- The altar of incense (Exo 30:1-10)
- The ark of the covenant (Exo 25:10-22)

But what does this have to do with our search for our King? In John 1, notice how "the Word" who was with God and was God is described:

And the Word became flesh and dwelt (literally,	
	$_$ ") among us, and we have
seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the	
Father, full of grace and truth. (1:14)	


The writer of *Hebrews* goes on to describe Jesus' deep connection to that Old Testament tabernacle:

- He entered "once for all" into the "greater and more perfect tent," into "_______ itself," thus "securing an eternal redemption" (9:11-12, 24)
- Therefore, we can have "confidence to ______
 the holy places by the blood of Jesus" (10:19-22)
