Psalms 34

I will bless the LORD at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth. ² My soul will make its boast in the LORD; The humble will hear it and rejoice. ³ O magnify the LORD with me, And let us exalt His name together. I sought the LORD, and He answered me, And delivered me from all my fears.

⁵ They looked to Him and were radiant, And their faces will never be ashamed. ⁶ This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him And saved him out of all his troubles.⁷ The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear Him, And rescues them. How do we demonstrate excellence in worship?

A. Psalms 34 is a great example of the benefits of worship

- 1. This is said to have been written by David after he sought asylum among the Philistines
 - (1 Sam 21:10-22:2)
 - he was running from King Saul
 - David had Goliath's sword with him
 - Fearing the King of Gath, David faked being crazy
 - He escaped to a cave and found safety
 - This Psalm was reflective of that time

2. Each verse begins with a letter of the Hebrew alphabet (easy to remember and recite)

The eyes of the LORD are toward the righteous And His ears are open to their cry. ¹⁶ The face of the LORD is against evildoers, To cut off the memory of them from the earth.¹⁷ The righteous cry, and the LORD hears And delivers them out of all their troubles. ¹⁸ The LORD is near to the brokenhearted And saves those who are crushed in spirit.

Many are the afflictions of the righteous, But the LORD delivers him out of them all. ²⁰ He keeps all his bones, Not one of them is broken.²¹ Evil shall slay the wicked, And those who hate the righteous will be condemned.²² The LORD redeems the soul of His servants. And none of those who take refuge in Him will be condemned.
