## SEARCHING FOR THE KING

Can you find **Joshua I** in your Bible? In **Joshua I**, the children of Israel needed a new leader. Moses had died! Who would lead them now? “\_\_\_\_\_” was the name of their new leader. But the children of Israel wouldn’t have said his name like we do in English. They would have called him, “**Yeshua.**” That’s a great name! It means “**Yahweh \_\_\_\_\_.**”

**But what does that have to do with our search for our King?** In **Matthew 1:18-21**, the birth of **OUR King** was promised by an angel. Listen to what that angel said about a young woman named Mary...

“She will bear a son, and you shall call his name \_\_\_\_\_, for he will save his people from their sins.”(**Matthew 1:21**)

We pronounce the name of Mary’s son, “**Jesus,**” but do you know how the Jews of the first century would have pronounced his name? “\_\_\_\_\_,” “**Yahweh saves.**” Jesus and Joshua had the same name!

Joshua was a great military general who courageously led the children of Israel into the Promised Land. But Jesus? Our King saves us from our sins! He’s not leading us into battles “**against flesh and blood**” with other people, but he **DOES** call each one of us to “**be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might.** Put on the whole

**armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil**” (**Ephesians 6:10-18**).

As we put on the armor of God and follow our King, where is he leading us? Not to the land of Israel. It’s even better! Jesus is leading us “**to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in \_\_\_\_\_ for you**” (**1 Peter 1:3-4**).

Our King—**Yeshua, “Yahweh saves”**—is the greatest conqueror of all!

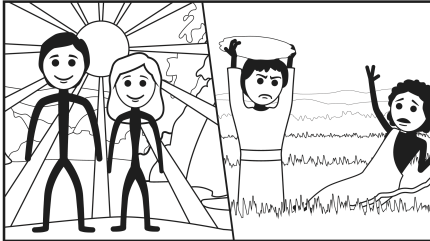

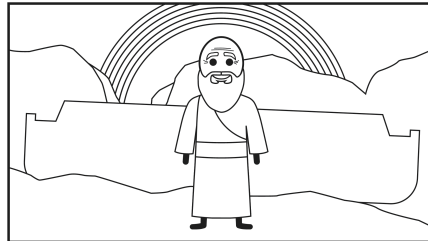
It's been a little while since we worked on our **Timeline**

**Building Blocks**, but they help us remember where we've been in our **Search For the King**.

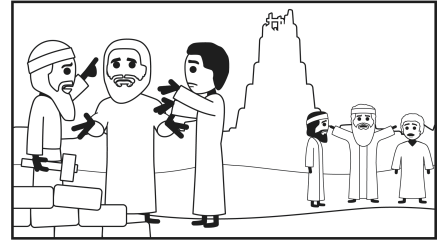
There are **17** time periods from **Creation to Revelation**. Do you remember the first 7?



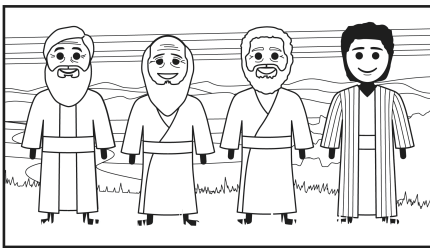
**Before the Flood**



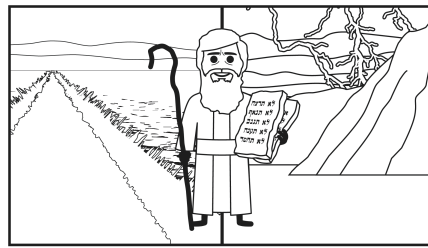
**Flood**



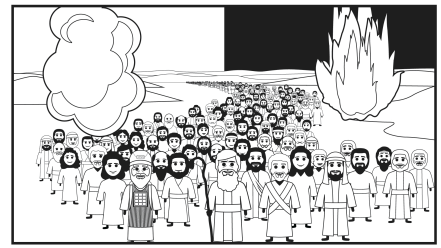

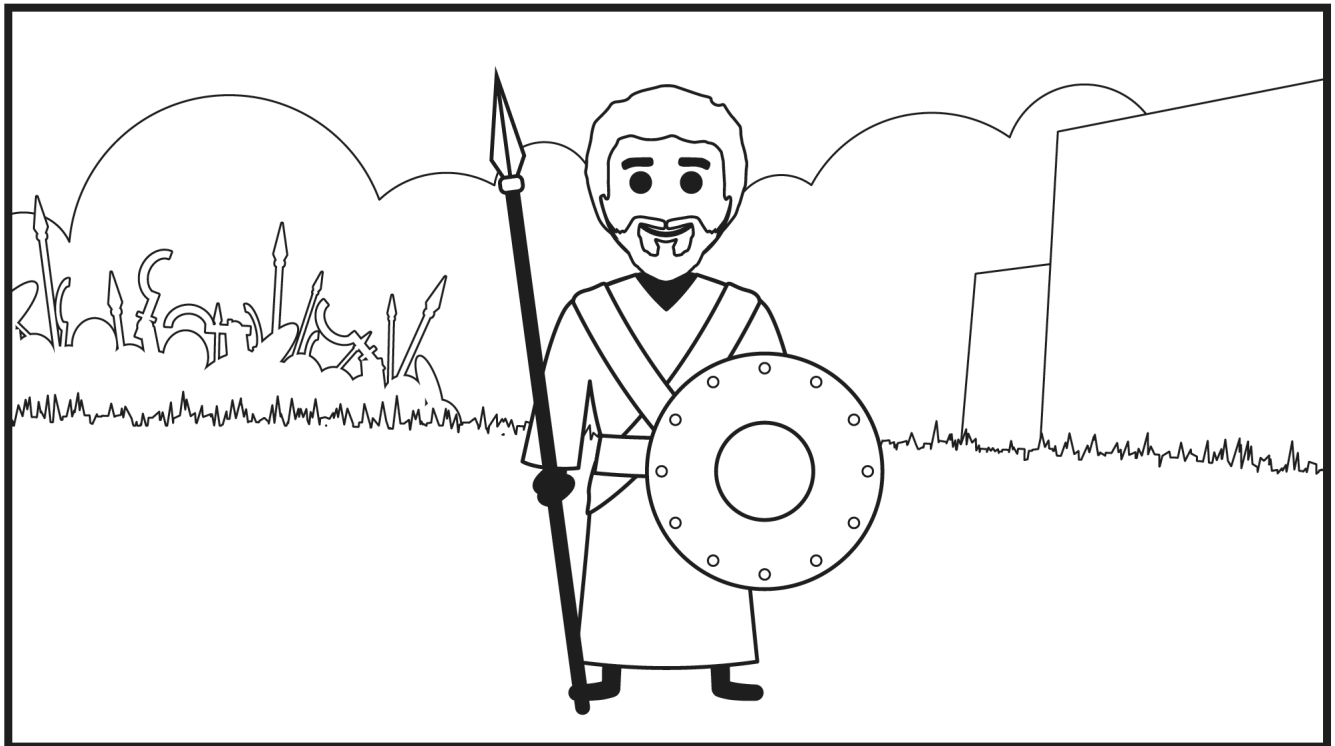
