But what does that have to do with our search for our Kin	ng? In Matthew 1:18-21, the birth of
OUR King was promised by an angel. Listen to what that angel	said about a young woman named
Mary	
"She will bear a son, and you shall call his name	, for he will save his
people from their sins." (Matthew 1:21)	
We pronounce the name of Mary's son, "Jesus," but do you kr	now how the Jews of the first century
would have pronounced his name? "	_ ," "Yahweh saves." Jesus and
Joshua had the came name!	

Joshua was a great military general who courageously led the children of Israel into the Promised Land. But Jesus? Our King saves us from our sins! He's not leading us into battles "against flesh and blood" with other people, but he DOES call each one of us to "be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. Put on the whole



armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil" (Ephesians 6:10-18).

As we put on the armor of God and follow our King, where is he leading us? Not to the land of Israel. It's even better! Jesus is leading us "to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in ______ for you" (I Peter I:3-4).

Our King-Yeshua, "Yahweh saves"—is the greatest conqueror of all!



There are 17 time periods from Creation to Revelation. Do you remember the first 7?











