one." In John 4:25-26, that's who Jesus claimed to be. "The <mark>anointed</mark> one." But why? What did he
mean?

In the Old Testament, we find three different groups of people being "anointed" with oil because they were being chosen for very special work:

- (1 Kings 19:16)
- **(Exodus 28:40-41)**
- (I Samuel 10:1)

But there was a really **BIG** problem. So many of those prophets, priests, and kings weren't the leaders God called them to be. Saul was Israel's very first king, but he didn't



turn out to be the leader the people needed. And the Old Testament tells us about king after king after king that didn't honor God the way they should and lead the people in the right path. So what would God do? God would send his OWN "anointed one." But who was it?

Do you remember how Matthew begins his gospel? In Matthew 1:1, this is what we read:


The book of the genealogy of _____ Christ...

Jesus is the King anointed by God himself! In Acts 4, the earliest Christians knew: Jesus is the holy servant "anointed" by God to do whatever the Father in heaven had "predestined to take place" (Acts 4:24-28). Jesus is the Christ, the Anointed One. Jesus is OUR king!
