- Proverbs 3:1-8 is such a rich section of wise instruction, we need to take our time and really think through what we're being told. What is the message, in your own words, of:
 - Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. (3:5)
 - In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths. (3:6)
 - Be not wise in your own eyes;
 fear the LORD, and turn away from evil. (3:7)
 - Let not steadfast love and faithfulness forsake you; bind them around your neck; write them on the tablet of your heart. (3:3)
- Why is God worthy of our trust? There are many answers to that question. Here's one: "he upholds the universe by the word of his power" (Heb 1:3). What does that mean?
- What does 2 Peter 3:4-7 add to our understanding of the matchless power of God's word?
- What difference could it make in my life if I developed and lived with the mindset Jesus taught in Matthew 5:45, that when I see the sun, I'm looking at "his sun"?
