



**Key texts:** Mark 16:1-7; John 21:1-19

On the shore of the Sea of Galilee, Peter is reminded of three life-changing moments...

**“Just as day was breaking...”** (John 21:4-8)

- Takes Peter back to (Luke 5:1-11) a \_\_\_\_\_ when he first realized: “Jesus is \_\_\_\_\_” and recognized his own \_\_\_\_\_.

**“When they had finished breakfast...”** (John 21:9-15a)

- Takes Peter back to an upper \_\_\_\_\_ in Jerusalem, what Jesus did after another \_\_\_\_\_ (John 13:3-5), and what Peter had confidently said (13:36-38).
- Takes Peter back to another charcoal \_\_\_\_\_ (John 18:15-18, 25-27) and his own \_\_\_\_\_ denials of Jesus.

**“Jesus said to Simon Peter...”** (John 21:15-19)

- Giving Peter opportunity to reaffirm his love for Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ times.
- Reassuring Peter he was ready to forgive, restore, and put him back to \_\_\_\_\_.
- Making clear that Peter could confidently say for the rest of his life, “\_\_\_\_ am \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_ is \_\_\_\_\_.” **How? What could Peter clearly see?**
  - Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ for him when he was weak (Luke 22:31-32).
  - Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ him when he failed.
