The Rest of the Book

This quarter we have walked through the first twelve chapters of Acts. We have seen powerful miracles. We have seen the incredible growth of the church and the door opened to the Gentiles. In this study we will rapidly look at the rest of the book of Acts. Here is a guick overview:

1. Starting in chapter 13 a shift takes place to the Apostle Paul

He becomes the central figure throughout the rest of the book The majority of Acts 13-21 traces Paul's three missionary journeys

- Paul visits 10 countries and 30 cities
- Nine of Paul's letters are written to churches or individuals in these regions
- (a) first journey (Acts 13-14)

AD 44-46

Travels about 1500 miles in two years

(b) second journey (Acts 16-18)

AD 49-51

Travels 3,000 miles and visits 21 cities

(c) third journey (18:23-21:17)

AD 52-54

Visits 18 cities

2. Paul's Trip to Rome (22-28)

Appears before Felix (24) Festus (25) Agrippa (26)

- ch 27 troubled voyage to Rome
- ch 28 in Rome (where prison letters written)

Much of the hardships during this period are summed up in 2 Cor 11:23-28

- Paul's use of Roman citizenship
- Final answer on circumcision & Gentiles
- Paul's incredible faith through trials
