This section of Joshua shows the nation entering the Promise land and the amazing story of the victory at Jericho.



Chapter 3: Crossing the Jordan

- 1. Joshua moves the nation 10 miles from Shittim to the edge of the Jordan
 - God speaks to Joshua and gives him the commands to follow
 - The Ark of the covenant, mentioned 26x in this section

The Jordan River is usually 30-40 yds wide and about 6 ft deep. This was the harvest time (3:15). The Jordan was more than a mile wide and turbulent.

The Ark was to be 2,000 cubits in front (4) as a direction You have not been this way before

- God stopped the Jordan at Zarethan (3:16) which was 30 miles upstream
- All the people crossed on dry land (4:10-11)

Chapter 4: Carrying Memorial Stones

1. Joshua chose 12 men to gather stones from the river bottom as a memorial. Stones were set up in Gilgal.

Chapter 6: The Conquest of Jericho

- 1. The men of war from Gad, Manasseh and Reuben numbered 40,000 (4:13)
 - God declared that the victory was in their hands (6:2)
 - They were to march once a day for six days.
 - This took away the element of surprise
- 2. On the 7th day, they were to march around 7 times.
 - Priests blew trumpets and the people shouted and the walls fell flat (20)
 - A ban prohibited Israel from taking things (6:17-19)
 - the two spies were to get Rahab and her family (6:22, 25)
 - the city was utterly destroyed (6:21) and burned (6:24)

Heb 11:30 "By faith the walls of Jericho fell down, after they had been circled for seven days."
