## **NEWS FROM ROME (Italy)**

Rome, August 6, 2023

Dear brethren in Christ,

my wife Antonella and I hope to find each one of you in good spiritual and physical health. We would like to share with you our sincere feelings of gratefulness for your fellowship in Christ, that makes possible our announcing of the gospel also in a city as Rome, the Capital of Bible ignorance and modern paganism. Every day we deal with all that and often we feel impotent and frustrated by the general spiritual indifference that is a great obstacle to our preaching. However, we trust in the power of the gospel to change what seems unchangeable. We'll do our best in putting all our energies in keeping on this important job.

**PERSONAL NEWS.** We're doing pretty good. Our medical checks are fine, and all seems under good control. Our daughter Valeria and her family are also doing well. Our three wonderful grandchildren (Alessandro 8 1/2 years, Alice 7, Samuele 3 1/2) are growing well and healthy. They are still enjoying their summer vacation time, waiting for September 12, when school will start. We have more time to be around them trying to be of some help.

Our son Paolo is also doing OK, real busy with his flight assistant job at Milan with the EasyJet Aircraft Company. Maybe he will be able to visit us by the end of August for few days. It will be good for the kids. We are also thinking about going up there to spend some time with him. We'll see.

**LOCAL PREACHING ACTIVITY.** Our local preaching work is going fine: busy and active. There're some internal small problems that need to be solved, as in all "normal churches", I guess. I learned in years that after some "black clouds", always comes the blue sky, and churches get stronger than before. These are moments of trial and opportunity to show and prof the real value of the group. To keep unity, brotherly love, and growth, sometimes are required some extra efforts and a lot of patience. These are precious moment of maturity.

I'm working to prepare our next gospel meeting, scheduled by the first week of October. On Thursday evening, I completed the book of Jude. We should start the study of one of the four gospels.

On Sunday, after the worship, I completed the study on "Divorce and second marriages" and I will start several lessons on the "Holy Spirit", touching all the delicate questions related to such a subject.

Our general attendance runs around 45 (including those brethren that still join us at distance through Zoom).
