


## The Conclusion of our Faith

What does v. 27 mean?

What did forgiving cost the lord?

How much is 100 denarii (28)?

The lord reversed and cancelled the forgiveness that he had extended.

- What does that mean to us?

The concluding passage (35) is similar to Mt 6:15 and James 2:13. Why is this so important to God?
