- We \_\_\_\_\_\_ with trust in God above (1 Pet 2:19-25)
- We \_\_\_\_\_\_ as recipients of his steadfast love (Psa 103:11-14; James 1:17)
- We live for the sake of \_\_\_\_\_\_ (Psa 148:11-13; Phil 2:9-11)
- We serve and shine and share as citizens of the \_\_\_\_\_\_ that is above (Isa 2:2-3; Col 3:1-4; 1 John 2:15-17)
