As we continue our study of How the O.T. ended, we now turn our attention to the book of **Nehemiah**.


1. After the fall of Babylon (Dan 5:30-31), Cyrus, the Persian king allowed the Jews to return to Jerusalem.

There were three waves of Jews returning to Jerusalem

- 1. 538 B.C. led by Zerubbabel: temple is rebuilt (Ezra 1:1-3)
- 2. 458 B.C. led by Ezra: the law is restored (Ezra 7:1)
- 3. 445 B.C. led by Nehemiah: the walls are rebuilt (Nehemiah)
- Most of the Jews DID NOT Return
- Estimated that 6 million Jews were killed in the Holocaust
- There are 7.6 million Jews living in the U.S.

B. The Momentum Factor

One of the key aspects of leading, whether at home, church, community or work is getting everyone on board.

• No one was building the walls of Jerusalem until Nehemiah showed up



A parked airplane at the terminal is held by yellow blocks (chocks) in front of the wheels. If the plane started to roll, those blocks would keep it from moving. However, when a plane is landing, those same yellow blocks on a runway would have no effect in slowing a plane down. It's the law of Momentum.
