MAKING THE CHOICE: "THIS IS MY GOD"
In Joshua 24, the old leader of Israel gathers all the tribes together. He tells them their family story (24:2-12), tracing it all the way to where they stood that day (24:13) and impresses upon them: "It's time to make choice" (24:14-15):
Put away all other
the LORD
Serve him in and in faithfulness
They made the choice: "He is God" (24:16-18, 31), but the next generation and multiple generations to come failed to make that same choice (Judg 2:10-23).
What does it look and sound like to make the choice today? How can I develop my own personal relationship with this same God?

* "By the grace of God, I can have a sincere, purified" (Titus 2:11-14a; 3:4-7; John 3:5; Acts 2:38)

"I no longer live for; I live for him." (2 Cor 5:14-15)
"I must keep myself from" (Judg 2:11-13; 1 John 5:21)
"I will walk, live by, and keep in step with the" (Gal 5:16-25)
