

2 Peter 1:7 and in your godliness, brotherly kindness, and in your brotherly kindness, love

Following godliness, Peter adds "brotherly kindness" to the list of qualities of a Christian's life. Kindness is often found with goodness or gentleness. Kindness is the way we treat others. Kindness is shown in acts of thoughtfulness or sweetness and is generated from a kind heart. Kindness is not something that one turns on and off. A person is kind, that is who they are.

In our English Bibles, we find two words: <u>Brotherly Kindness</u>. This is not to imply that we are only kind to each other, brothers. Galatians 6:10 teaches us to do good to all people, especially those of the household of faith.

In the Greek, <u>Brotherly Kindness</u>, is one word. It is the word ______ —the warm, emotional love and bond between others.
