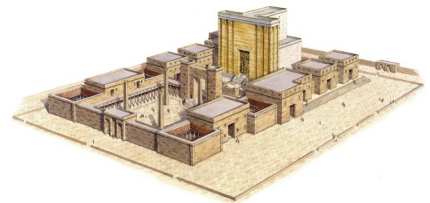


What is WORSHIP?
