This morning's sun dawned on all sorts of people. We've traveled different paths in the past, we're experiencing unique blessings and challenges in the present, even as we anticipate varying opportunities and responsibilities in the days ahead.

Take a moment to think about these differences in the light of Psalm 70. David describes some as seeking a relationship with God. "May all who seek you rejoice and be glad in you!" (70:4a) Are you seeking this morning? If so, we're so glad you're here and want to encourage you to find your joy and sense of purpose in a relationship with your Creator. We're here to help.

David describes some who have sought, found, and now are leading lives of praise to their Savior. "May those who love your salvation say evermore, 'God is great!'" (70:4b). What a great thought to fuel our hearts for worship. Let's sing, pray, study, reflect, and encourage each other with hearts full of love for the God who graciously loved us first.

Whatever my burden or blessing, it's critical that I bring the right sort of heart before the throne of God today. Are you confidently celebrating spiritual victory today? Bring a humble heart to him. We've gathered together, not because we're worthy or sufficient on our own, but because our Help desires to be found and our Deliverer is worthy of a lifetime of praise. So let's bring him our best today.

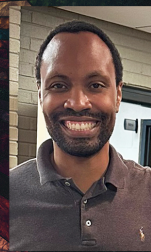
