

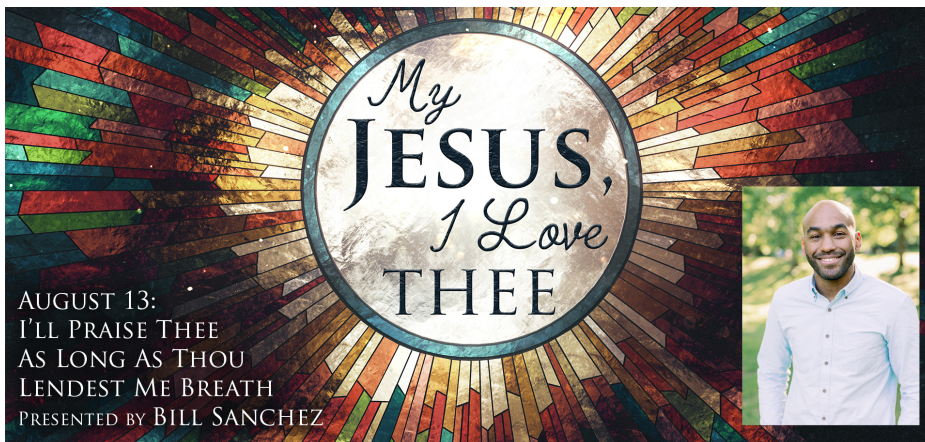

The One King Who Never Weakens

Psalm 72 is "of Solomon," a prayer to God for the king.

Give the king your justice, O God, and your righteousness to the royal son! (72:1)

Hope is expressed that the king would rule in the right way:

May he judge your people with righteousness... (72:2)

May he defend the cause of the poor... (72:4)

May he be like rain that falls on the mown grass... (74:6)

In his days may the righteous flourish... (74:7)

Petitions are made for the boundaries of his reign to increase:

May he have dominion from sea to sea... (72:8)

May all kings fall down before him... (72:11)

Even his health and legacy are prayerfully considered:

Long may he live... (72:15)

May his fame continue as long as the sun! (72:17)

And yet, 3,000 years after Psalm 72 was written, we continue to have periodic reminders: righteous or wicked, kings don't reign forever. Adored or despised, queens pass from this life. The sun eventually sets on every fragile reign as human rulers "go the way of all the earth" (1 Kgs 2:2).

But before Psalm 72 concludes, our attention is drawn higher. "Blessed be the LORD, the God of Israel, who alone does wondrous things. Blessed be his glorious name forever; may the whole earth be filled with his glory! Amen and Amen!" As kings pass and queens fade, one King never changes or weakens. The Lord our God the Almighty reigns today. What a privilege to come before his holy throne in worship!
