My "conduct" flows from my attitude (1:17; 2:11-12; 3:1-2, 15-16) and one of the words that ought to describe the attitude of Jesus' disciples is \_\_\_\_\_, a word used by Paul in 1 Timothy 2:8-10. **Notice the "conduct"...**

- "\_\_\_\_\_ " (*kosmeō*): to put in order, arrange
- "\_\_\_\_\_ " (*kosmios*): orderly, well-arranged, harmonious

### **...and the attitude of the heart from which the conduct flows...**

- With "modesty": \_\_\_\_\_, reverence, respectful reserve
- With "\_\_\_\_\_ -control": rational (Acts 26:25), soundness of mind, regulated

### **An attitude of modesty has just as much to do with "too much"...**

- \_\_\_\_\_ too much of myself (Psa 49:6; Matt 6:1-18; Rom 12:3)
- \_\_\_\_\_ "too much" (1 Tim 2:9)

### **...as "too little."**

- Thinking too \_\_\_\_\_ of myself (1 Cor 12:15-23a)
- \_\_\_\_\_ too little (1 Cor 12:23b-24; Isa 3:16-26; Jer 8:12; Prov 7:10; Rev 3:18)

### **What's the motivation for a Christian?**

- "I \_\_\_\_\_ to God" (1 Cor 6:19-20), "so what does God want me to \_\_\_\_\_?" (1 Tim 2:10; Eph 5:8-10)
- "What \_\_\_\_\_ thinks matters more than anyone and I'm committed to growing to think more and more like him (Eph 4:17-20; 5:3-4), so what does God see as 'very \_\_\_\_\_'?" (1 Pet 3:1-4)
