- Hades is where all the dead go until the coming of Jesus
- There remains memory, identity, feelings and concern in hades
- There is a separation and no changing places in hades
- The destination is based upon life's choices about God

Luke 16 fits as a parable in context (15:11; 16:1) - there is some symbolism within the story. The purpose of Jesus telling this is based upon Luke 16:14-15 Who represents the rich man in this

 - In Heaven we will see God (Rev 22:4)
 - In Heaven we will be with _____ the righteous of all time (right now, some righteous are in hades and some remain here on earth)
 - Since there are no tears in Heaven, will there be no tears in hades?
 Lazarus was comforted
 Jesus referred to Hades as Paradise (Persian word for the grand parks of Persia)
