How is prophesying different from preaching?

A. Silence in the church (1 Cor 14:29-35)

The context is instructions about spiritual gifts (which prophesy was one— 12:10)

What do we know about spiritual gifts?

- What does it mean that the "spirits of the prophets" are subject to the prophets (1 Cor 14:32)
- women are not permitted to speak (34)/it is improper (disgraceful) for a woman to speak in church (35)

Some contend that women being silent was a cultural practice in those days and not intended for all time
