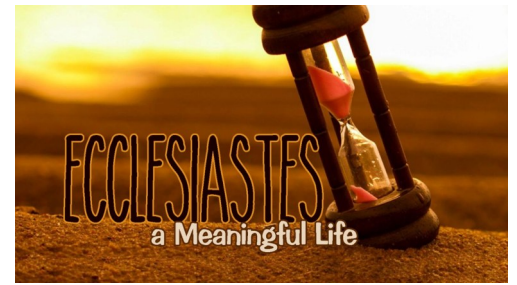


Questions for Chapter Two:
