We are daily in the midst of Bible ignorance, human traditions, religious superstitions, modern paganism. Anyhow, we're striving to do what we can to announce God's Will in this arid "desert". We certainly hope and pray to find good people with whom to bring good fruit to the Lord.

PERSONAL NEWS. We are doing just fine, in spite of our coming age. We are under regular check controls and all seems to proceed well. Our three lovely grandchildren (Alessandro, Alice, Samuele) are also doing fine. They are daily particularly busy with school activities and homework, and we try to help as much as we can. To be grandparents is really a heavy job!

Our son Paolo is doing fine. Busy with his job but happy to be back in Rome. He's helping the local work and improving in many things. As I already wrote, he could be a strong source for the future of this work. We need to work in this direction, avoiding to waste all the spiritual things done in so many years.

LOCAL PREACHING ACTIVITY. Our local work is keeping on fine, with passion and good judgements. Especially the young group of brethren is growing well, becoming a good example to the rest of congregation. We are proud of our real unity and spiritual strength, after coming out of a difficult moment, due to some evil attempts of discouragements.
