WELCOME

We're glad you're here today. Here's what you can expect in our **Sunday morning assembly**:

Life is all about choices. Some of those choices are relatively inconsequential in the grand scheme of things. "What do you want to eat for lunch?" But it's not an overstatement to say that some choices are immeasurably more weighty because they will impact the rest of your time on earth and shape your experience of eternity. Psalm 119:30 describes one such choice. "I have chosen the way of faithfulness."

What does it look like and sound like to be on "the way of faithfulness"? We don't have to look any farther than the surrounding verses. Just listen to the way the psalmist prays.

- "Give me life according to your word!"
- "Teach me your statutes."
- "Make me understand the way of your precepts, and I will meditate on your wondrous works."
- "Strengthen me according to your word!"
- "Put false ways far from me and graciously teach me your law."
- "I set your rules before me."
- "I cling to your testimonies, O LORD."
- "I will run in the way of your commandments."

Who knows how many relatively small choices you'll make this week. "What am I going to wear?" "Which route will I take home?" "At what temperature should I set my thermostat?" But no one can make the Psalm 119:30 choice for you, and few (if any) things matter more. "I have chosen the way of faithfulness." Have you made that choice yet? If not, why not make it today?

Psalm 119: 22 stanzas, each with 8 verses. Within each stanza, the first word of each verse begins with the same letter. Stanza by stanza, the psalm gradually works through all 22 letters of the Hebrew alphabet. The theme? God's _____ (119:88-89, 1-9).


