## Sanctification

### - Sanctified -

Among the great words of salvation is "Sanctification." It is a very practical as well as a much misunderstood concept.

1. Sanctification has a dual process
  - an act of salvation completed by God
  - on going process of spiritual growth that we are actively involved in

#### Key Passages:

- 1 Corinthians 6:11 "Such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were **sanctified**, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God."
- John 17:17 "**Sanctify** them in the truth; Your word is truth"
- 1 Peter 3:15 "but **sanctify** Christ as Lord in your hearts, always being ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence."
- Hebrews 10:10 "By this will we have been **sanctified** through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all."
- Heb 13:12 "Therefore Jesus also, that He might **sanctify** the people through His own blood, suffered outside the gate
- 1 Thessalonians 4:3 "For this is the will of God, your **sanctification**; that you abstain from sexual immorality."

#### Understanding the Word:

The word 'sanctification,' comes from the Greek word "Hagiasmos". That is derived from hagiazo which means to make 'Holy' or 'Consecrate.'

1. The idea of sanctification is to separate from the world or to set apart for God's use (special, designated, holy)- it is more than just being different. It is an act of God and a continuing choice on our part
2. In saving us through the blood of Christ, God has made us holy and separate from the world (Acts 26:18)  
1 Pet 2:9
